## **Outline**

- Poster session will be held by using Remo, one of the Web conferencing systems which provides virtual space like a big party place with tables which limited people can be seated.
- A poster presenter will be assigned to one table (just like using poster board in the venue) and upload their poster data to their Remo table.
- There will be 7 poster floors and participants can choose which floor you want to go by using "Floor".
- Remo which can provide almost real conference on virtual space, is adopted because communication and socialization.
- Please read the following carefully before participation for poster session.





# Preparation\_1. Preparation of Poster file

We have <u>no template</u> for the poster presentation.

Any size of the poster is allowed if Remo can handle it. For maximum accessibility by all attendees, we recommend making the file as small as possible. We recommend your PDF or jpg file size of 1 MB or less.

The following files can be uploaded to the board from your device or the web:



### Mixing time @ 8th Floor




You can discuss and answer the chat during the "Mixing time"
Click "Return to Poster Session" at the top left of Screen, you can back to Poster Session Floor.


You use "Whiteboard" +" Camera" + "Microphone"



#### Go to Create " Miro" account


You paste your poster without Miro account, please Skip Page 10 and go to Page 11.










# 4. Paste your Poster on Whiteboard


1) After creating Miro account, back to Remo

3) Upload your poster data from your device.



Please click "Upload">>"My device", you can choose the file for poster session from your device.


### 4) Fit the poster to your screen.




"Fit to Screen" button

## 5) Lock your poster




#### Please note:

- 1. Only 3 most recently created boards could be editable by free Miro account. If you plan to have several poster presentations at ISMAR-APNMR 2021, we recommend you to remove your poster data soon once your poster session has been finished.
- 2. You Can NOT lock your poster without Miro account.

  If your uploaded poster has been deleted or changed by someone, please uploaded again.

### 6) Presentation

Complete the preparation for your presentation and back to your table until your "Core time". Please discuss with the attendees at your Core time.



7) After the "Mixing time", please remove your poster.

4. Please remove your poster from whiteboard by the end of Mixing time.

If you forget removing the poster, after "Mixing time", you can not back to online poster session event, but your poster data is stored in "your" Miro account.

#### <Core time>

The presenters whose Program No. is odd number (e. g. P1-1-1) are allotted "Core time (60 minutes)" in the first half of the session time. The remaining half (60 minutes) is for the presenters whose Program No. is even number (e. g. P1-1-2). You should stay at your table for discussion with the attendees during your "Core time (60 minutes)" as mentioned above.
