it is my sad duty to inform you that Richard Ernst, Nobel Prize in Chemistry 1991, passed away last Friday in his care home in Winterthur after a long illness.

We have lost one of the pioneers that shaped the development of magnetic resonance. Richard developed many of the concepts and tools that we use in NMR and MRI today. He was not only a great scientist but also a patient teacher for his students with many other interests besides science. He was well known for his collection of Tibetan Thangkas (wall paintings), his interest in Tibetan culture, and for his love of classical music.

We will miss him and always remember him.
